
External Passive Intermodulation (PIM)

PIM occurs when two or more wireless signals mix together and create additional frequencies that cause interference and deteriorate network performance.

Common Causes:

- Loose metal-to-metal contacts
- · Poor quality components that rust or corrode
- Metal shavings or other site contamination
- Nearby frequency sources (power lines/equipment)
- Obstacles in the RF path including supports for stealth enclosures

PIM: the lower, the better




Hi-Risk PIM Zone

The Hi-Risk PIM zone exists in close proximity to the antenna; in front, above, below, and even behind it. The zone is defined as:

- Ten feet directly above or below the antenna
- Five feet behind the antenna
- One hundred feet in front of the antenna

Standard installation practices and products must be modified within the Hi-Risk zone to avoid PIM. Many traditional installation products including metal cable hangers, hose clamps, poor quality components with rust or corrosion and loose hardware or brackets have been identified as being PIM generators and must be eliminated.

- Substitute composite for metal where possible
- Minimum number of parts and junctions
- Hot dipped galvanized steel for corrosion resistance
- High contact pressure junctions




